VOLTZ (ISIN : FR0000065971 – mnemonic : GRVO) informs the market that the liquidity contract concluded with the brokerage firm Gilbert Dupont, and implemented on its shares, ended on March 31, 2026.

This termination follows the definitive cessation of activities of the brokerage firm Gilbert Dupont. No transactions have been carried out under this contract since that date.

As of the termination date of the contract, March 31, 2026, the liquidity account opened in the books of the brokerage firm Gilbert Dupont held 2,208 GRVO shares and €206,524.15 in cash. The shares have been registered in pure registered form.

As of the date of this press release, VOLTZ has not concluded a new liquidity contract with another investment service provider.
