

Dutreil Agreement: commitments to retain shares in Graines Voltz

Graines Voltz has been informed that on December 19, 2025, certain shareholders of the company signed a Dutreil Agreement (commitments to retain Graines Voltz shares for the purposes of Article 787 B of the French General Tax Code) in connection with donations by Serge Voltz to his children, his wife, and Hugo Bony of shares in Albatros, which holds 57.06% of the capital and voting rights of Graines Voltz. This transaction benefited from an exemption granted by the French Financial Markets Authority (Autorité des marchés financiers, “AMF”) from the mandatory filing of a draft public offer for Graines Voltz shares, dated December 18, 2025 and reproduced in D&I No. 225C2157.

In accordance with AMF Position 2004-02, the characteristics of this Dutreil Agreement are as follows:
